

Seizure on 3/8/67 of 500 cartons of unstamped cigarettes

Reference is made to the resolution dated January 17, 1967, approved by the Tax Commission, which authorizes the director and assistant director of our bureau, the regional tax supervisor, the director of special investigations bureau and the New York district tax supervisor to remit or abate penalties in the amount of \$5,000 or less imposed pursuant to paragraph b, subdivision 1, of section 481 of the Tax Law.

Attached please find the May 24 memorandum from the Special Investigations Bureau in which they recommend that the above cigarette assessment in the amount of \$18,625 be reduced to \$800 for the following reasons:

- This was the first arrest of above individual with motion granted to suppress evidence and our complaint dismissed by the Judge.
- 2. He lives with his father (84) who is blind and mother (83) who is senile.
- 3. His occupation is a butcher and weekly income is \$100.00.

It is recommended that the Tax Commission approve reducing Att. Manual Manual Action of \$500.00 will be paid in beginning June 15, 1968.

Att. Manual Ma this assessment to \$800. We are holding in our file the check for \$300 received with the enclosed memorandum from the Special Investigations Bureau, and the balance of \$500.00 will be paid in monthly installments of \$100 each beginning June 15, 1968.
