

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Article 8, Section
(Twentieth) of the Tax Law and the authority vested therein,
the Tax Commission does hereby abate penalties in the amount
of \$557,020.00.

2. Accordingly, the amount of penalty imposed is reduced
to \$11,980.00. Said amount to be computed as follows:

300 cartons at \$4.00 = \$ 1,200.00
5,390 cartons at \$2.00 = \$10,780.00
