

I am writing you this note with the hope that you may initiate a final disposition by your commission of the above stated matter which has been pending before your office for several years.

On the date of February 25, 1971 (per enclosed copy) I wrote to Arthur Maxwell regarding the matter and on the date of March 2, 1971 I received a reply which is attached hereto.
