


In accordance with Mr. Dautner's memorandum of September 18, 1975, enclosed herewith, I recommend the cancellation of the notice of deficiency in the above matter.



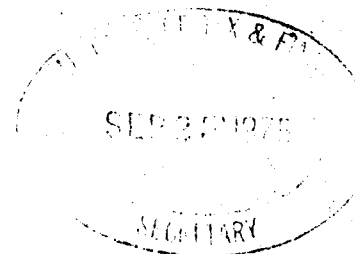

SUBJECT: Petition of Domenick and Anna Stanick

This is a South Mall case. The amount involved is \$417.70. Mr. Stanick returned the questionnaire but failed to sign the submission waiver. From the amount of additional income demanded by the Income Tax Bureau (\$6000), I would estimate Mr. Stanick worked for approximately 60 weeks in Albany on the supposition he received about \$100 per week for expenses. Since the work period was approximately one year in duration, I would recommend a finding in Mr. Stanick's favor. Within the guidelines of the Matter of Ervin Ross, the employment should be deemed temporary.
