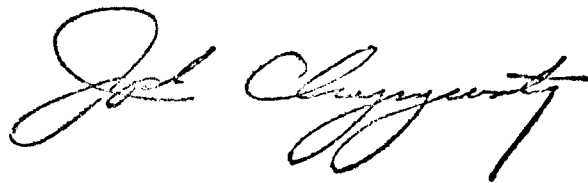
Dear Mr. Cox:

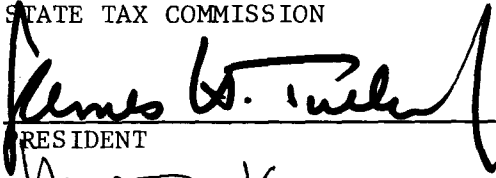

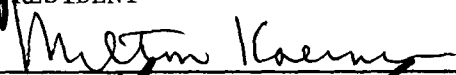

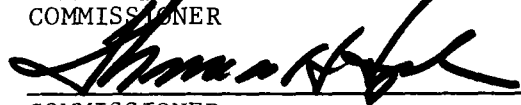
