it is



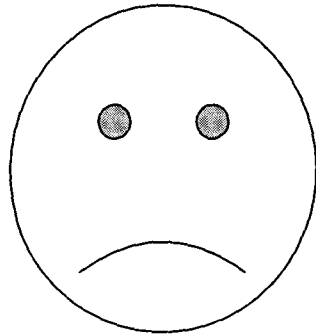

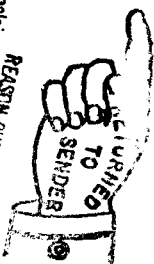
