ORDERED that the petition of Ira M. & Barbara M. Bierman be and the same is hereby denied.

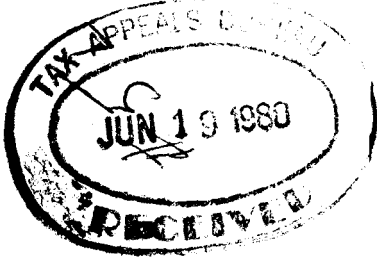

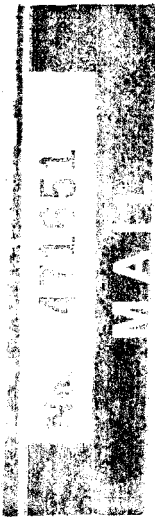


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
