
Dear Mr. & Mrs. Stewart:

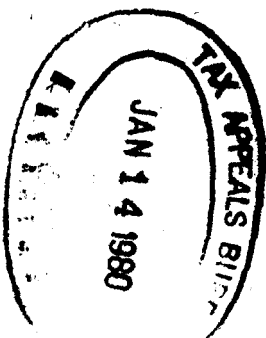

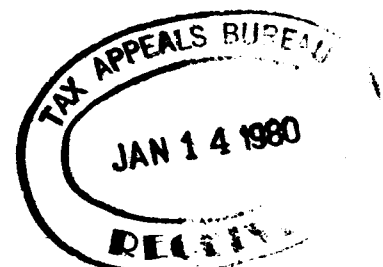
Dear Madam:
