

ORDERED that the petition of Reginald and Daryl Stuart be and the same is hereby denied.

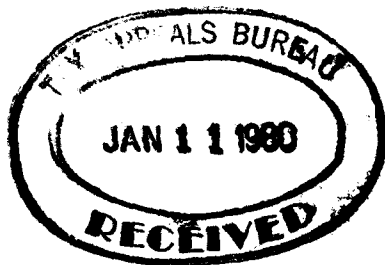

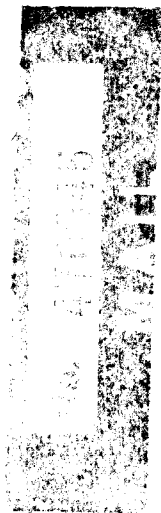
