
Dear Mr. & Mrs. Cavosi:

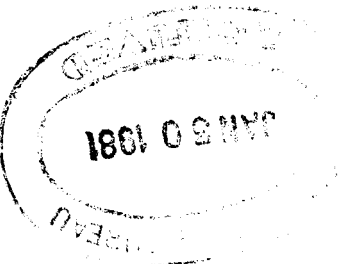
