Please find copy of default order 81-P-45, dated 1-29-82. The taxpayers have been misled and are requesting the default order to be vacated. To understand their position it is necessary to review salient points in these rather bizarre course of events.

A petition was filed in October of 1979, and resulted in prehearing conference on June 3, 1980. After considerable efforts and substantiation the taxpayers and other conferencesarrived at amounts as follows:

> 1975 & 76 \$1460.64 Sec. 685 77.66 1976 - \$1804.10 Sec. 90.21 1977 - \$221.98 Sec. 685 11.01 Plus interest on all years.

The taxpayers former representative Mr. Albert A. Siegel was requested to sign Withdrawal of Petition and Discontinuance of Case and pay the stated agreed amounts. The amounts were paid by the taxpayer but the representative Mr. Albert Siegel inserted on the Withdrawal of Petition and Discontinuance of Case as being paid "Under Protest". This can be verified by copy of correspondence from Kathleen Beraurd N.Y.S. Conferee dated 6-16-81. The advice rendered to the taxpayers is that the matter was closed, and to pay the agreed amounts in tax, penalties and interest.

The taxpayers with all sincerity wish the default order of 1-29-82 vacated; and the Notice and Demand for Payment of Income Tax Due be rescinded. A conference is requested to close the matter on the agreed amounts established at the Pre-conference hearing. The taxpayers were under the misunderstanding that this matter was closed. It is our intent to comply with a signed withdrawal of petition and discontinuance or any other document to this effect. 
