DEFAULT ORDER

Petitioner, Bethlehem Auto Laundry, Inc., Nine Woodridge Road, Delmar, New York 12054, filed a petition for a revision of a determination or for refund of sales and use taxes under Articles 28 and 29 of the Tax Law for the period December 18, 1965 through May 31, 1966.
