In a memorandum dated April 29, 1968, copy of which is attached, the above vendor was granted permission to liquidate its tax liability over an 18 month period, in accordance with the authority for entering into deferred payment agreements granted in Memorandum No. E-37.

The attached letter dated September 15, 1969 from I. Stanley Kriegel & Co., accountants for the vendor, was forwarded to me with a memorandum from Mr. Samuel Michelson dated October 6, 1969 explaining that the vendor is unable to meet the final payment of \$9,818.81 plus accrued interest due under the agreement on October 15, 1969. The vendor has requested an extension of time for meeting this obligation and has submitted a plan for making payment thereof, as follows:

a) October 15, 1969	\$ 2,500.00
b) November 15, 1969	2,500.00
c) December 15, 1969	2,500.00
d) January 15, 1970	2,318.81
e) February 15, 1970	Interest to be paid in Full

Based upon the good faith shown by the vendor in making payments under the plan during the first 17 months of this agreement, it is recommended that the plan outlined on page 2 of the letter from I. Stanley Kriegel & Co. be approved.

In accordance with the provisions of Memorandum No. E-37 the approval of the State Tax Commission is required since the entire period for payment will extend over a period time in excess of 18 months. See bottom of this form for signature lines if this plan is approved.
