

hearing. A default has been duly noted.


Now on motion of the attorney for the Department of Taxation  
and Finance, the assessment is reduced by \$182.70, representing


that portion of the assessment predicated upon a bulk sale by taxpayer to Ed V. Barnet, as it could not be established that such bulk sale was effected, and it is

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
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
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
