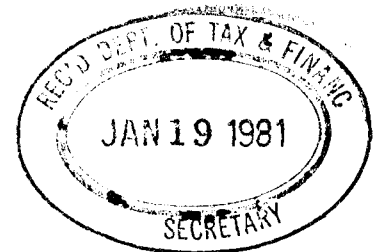
Enclosed please find a xerox copy of Default Order #80-P-36.
