
Dear Mr. Perry:

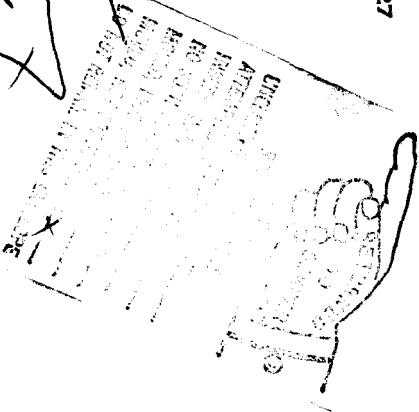

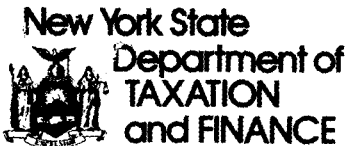

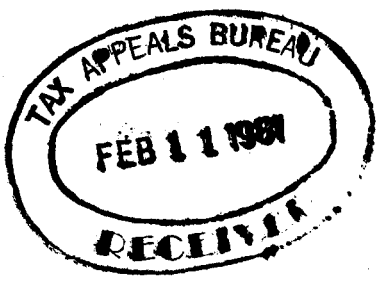
