

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

Petitioners, Sami Sari and Beril Yardimci, d/b/a Sari Luncheonette, filed a petition for revision of a determination or for refund of sales and use taxes under Articles 28 and 29 of the Tax Law for the period September 1, 1974 through August 31, 1977.

A small claims hearing on the petition was scheduled before Arthur Johnson, Hearing Officer, at the offices of the State Tax Commission, Two World Trade Center, Room 65-51, New York, New York, on March 13, 1984 at 9:15 A.M. Notice of said small claims hearing was given to petitioners and their representative, Melih Dogan. Petitioner Sami Sari appeared at 10:30 A.M. and requested an adjournment because his bookkeeper was unexpectedly called out of the country. The request for adjournment was denied and petitioner was given the option of going forward with the hearing at that time or on the following day at 9:15 A.M. Petitioner chose not to go forward with the hearing without his bookkeeper being present.

A hearing previously scheduled for January 27, 1984 was adjourned at the request of Melih Dogan.

Petitioners did not appear at a pre-hearing conference scheduled for December 13, 1978 and a default order was issued August 17, 1979. The default order was subsequently vacated.

Now on motion of the attorney for the Department of Taxation and Finance, it is


ORDERED that the petition of Sami Sari and Beril Yardimci, d/b/a Sari Luncheonette be and the same is hereby denied.
