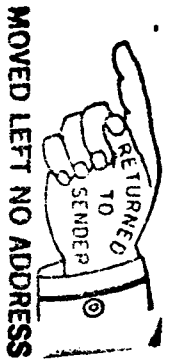

ORDERED that the petition of Charles A. Rebeck d/b/a Charlie's Superette be and the same is hereby denied.

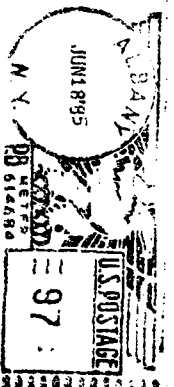
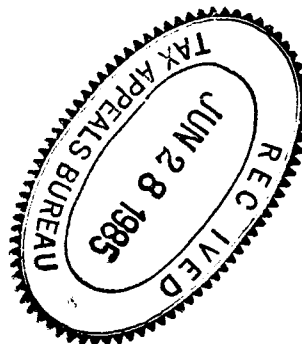

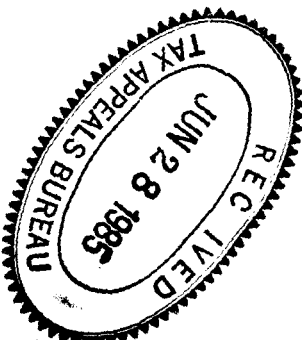
