
Dear Ms. Pender:

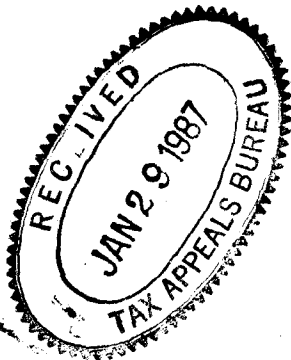
