Notice of said hearing was given to petitioner and petitioner's representative. No one appeared for the taxpayer. A default was duly recorded.


On motion of the attorney for the Department of Taxation and Finance, Saul Heckelman, Esq. (Albert J. Rossi, Esq., of Counsel), it is
