
Dear Mr. Schmidt:

ORDERED that the petition of Charles Schmidt be and the same is hereby denied.



Perfected Petition forms are enclosed for your convenience.

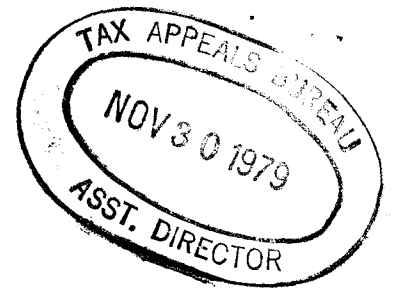

I have received a notice of a Default Order dated October 31, 1979.

I am writing you at this time to request that the default be vacated. The accountant who handled this matter, A. D. Goldstein, has advised me that he had retired in July of this year, and apparently did not file certain papers necessary for our case.

If you would be good enough to explain my rights at this time, I am prepared to retain another accountant.

I have been advised that I do owe an amount of tax for the year 1974, but that the amount assessed by the state is incorrect.

The Capital gain portion was on a building that was not owned by the business and therefore should be excluded from the calculation.

Enclosed are photocopies showing that the business was in my name but the real property was owned by both Charles & Mary Schmidt.

I trust the above will be sufficient to settle this matter and await your early response.

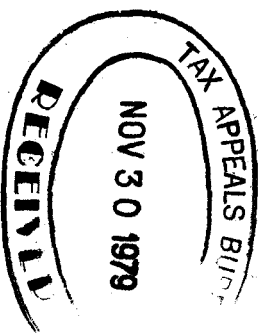
