
Dear Mr. Wooster:

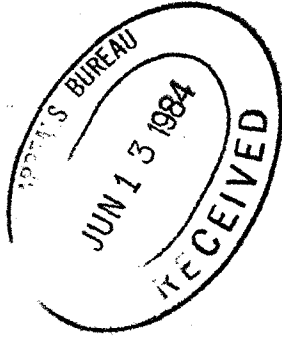
Now on motion of the attorney for the Department of Taxation and Finance, it is

ORDERED that the petition of Thomas A. Wooster be and the same is hereby denied.

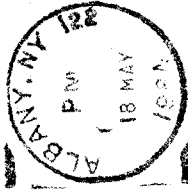

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
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
